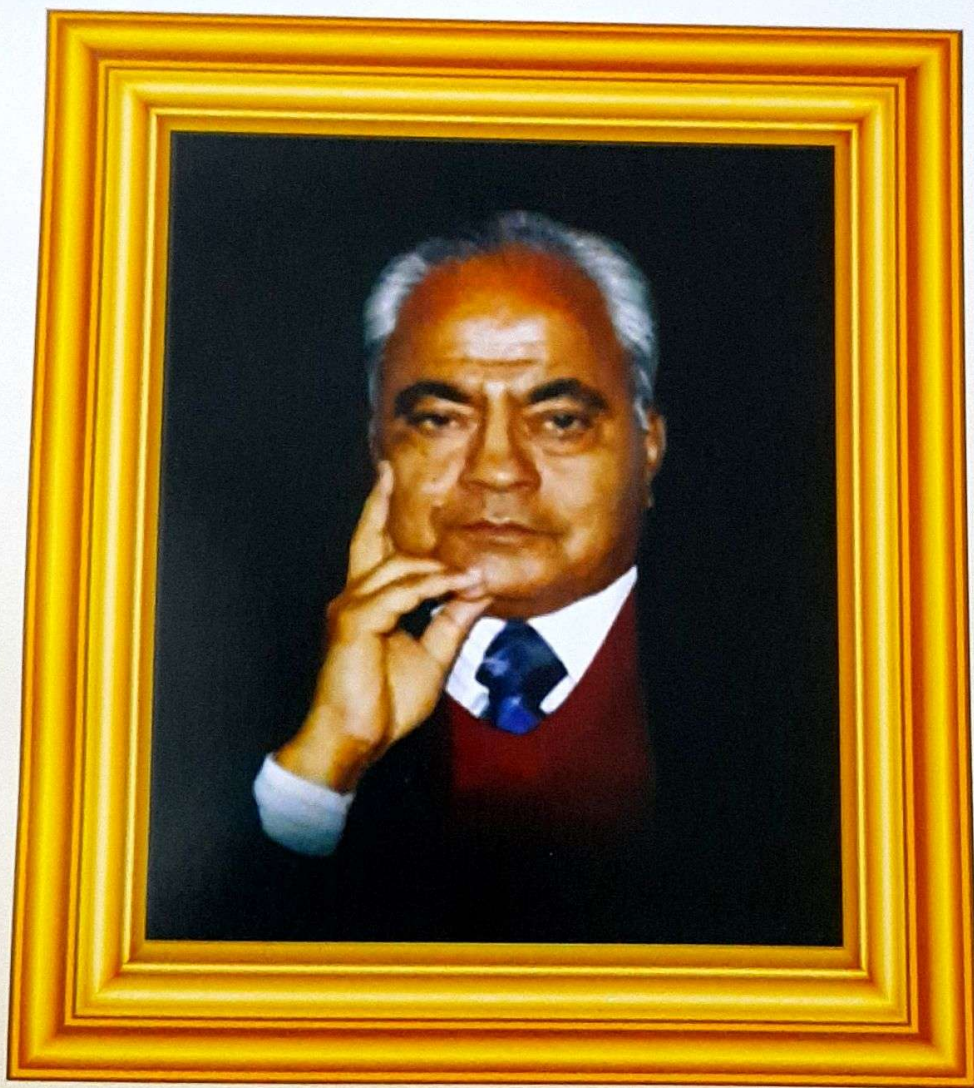

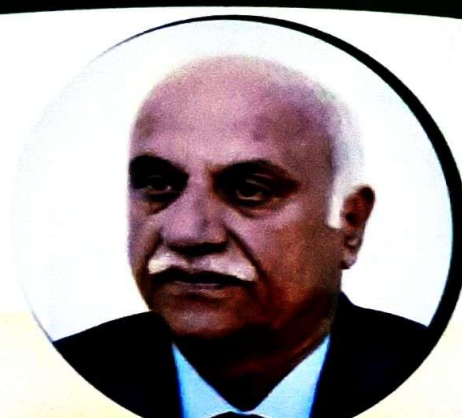
Dear Parents

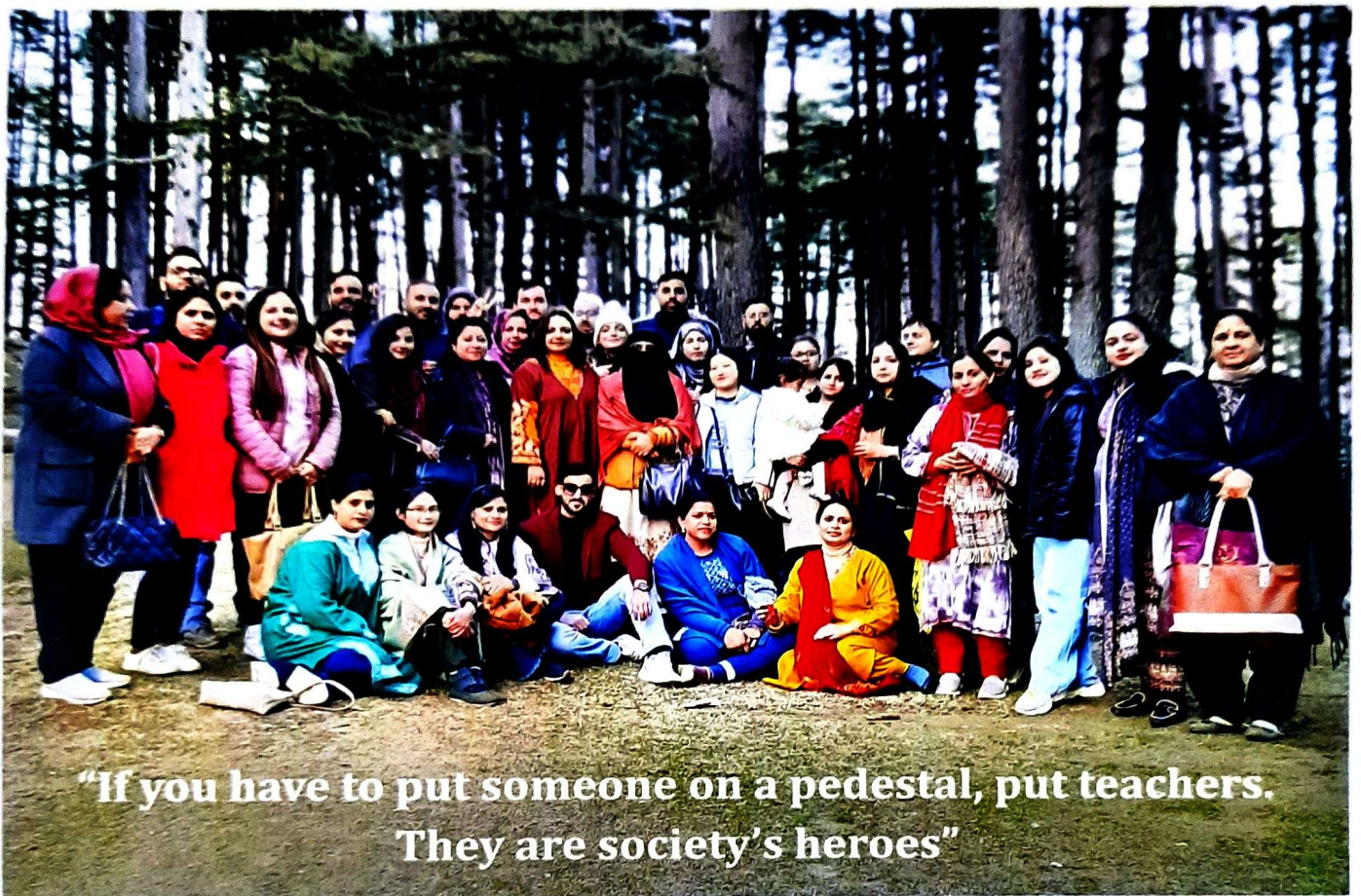

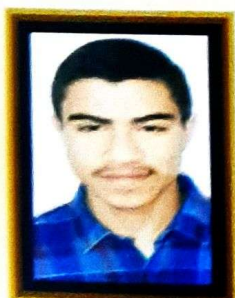

Academic Programme

Pre-primary Programme

The pre-primary programme inculcates in children the qualities of curiosity, exploration and discovery in a fun-filled, safe and happy learning environment. An individualized approach helps nurture a love of learning, develop social skills, and instill moral values. The emphasis is on developing in students self-confidence in English as well as in their mother tongue; teachers ensure this through effective use of language and by encouraging children to express themselves freely.

The pre-primary programme makes use of range of individual and group activities which create a live and positive learning environment. Games, songs, creative projects, story-telling, role-playing, drawing and painting helps develop children's foundational skills in literacy and numeracy. They are encouraged to play, explore and discover through dance, music, art & craft. Singing, rhyming and reciting are employed in the Language Arts, and the Phonics programme. The use of manipulatives, pictures and symbols helps them identify relationships between sets and groups of things to be sorted, counted, shared and represented. Sports and interaction with sports teachers help in strengthening coordination and motor skills, and instill enthusiasm for sports.

Primary School Programme

The primary school programme encourages inquiry and exploration, and develops childrens' competence in various skills like reading, writing, listening, speaking, problem-solving, observation, measurement and use of information and communication technology.

A wide range of curricular and co-curricular opportunities offered helps instill in children confidence and discipline. The focus on developing communication skills helps them appreciate the value of education, as it reflects in their ability to express themselves to developing pragmatic skills. Field trips, excursions, activities, projects and presentations provide experimental learning opportunities. Dance, Fine Arts, Western and Indian Music, Yoga, Speech and Drama promote well rounded development. Students are encouraged to participate in inter-house cultural and sports events. Active learning techniques like free play, dramatisation, puppetry, singing, dancing and cooking enhance their interests in learning. Book, newspaper and magazine reading activities increase childrens' awareness of the world. Assemblies, concerts and drama production help shape their confidence.





Academic Programme

Middle School Programme

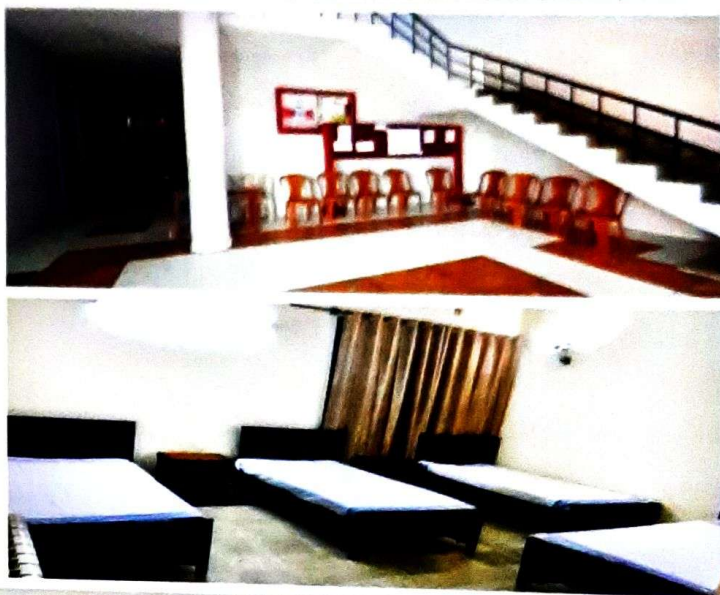
The middle school programme is structured to meet children's varied intellectual and developmental needs. The main aims of the programme are developing skills to writing, reading, reflecting, critical-thinking, public speaking, fostering initiative among students and a desire to acquire knowledge. Academic subjects include English, Hindi/Urdu, Mathematics, Science, History, Civics, Geography, Art, Drama, Computer Science, Music, Yoga, Dance are integrated to the mainstream curriculum and are further strengthened as optional co-curricular activities.

High School Programme

At KBPS, the curriculum starts with an emphasis on learning basic facts and gradually moves to detailed understanding of concepts, through interpretation and evaluation as students' progress to higher classes. Projects and application of knowledge form an integral part and the development of analytical skills. The programme aims to empower children to contribute towards a humane, just and pluralistic society, and promote introspective living. School organizes inter-house cultural and sports events, thus developing leadership skills and team spirit.



Maulana Azad Memorial Girls & Boys Hostel



The School is equipped with fully furnished hostels for girls and boys. The hostels are specially designed with two primary objectives of safety and comfort. They have round-the-clock security, with stringent security procedures and comfortable environment that our students enjoy living in. The hostels have state-of-the-art washrooms (toilet and bathing cells). Cleanliness is maintained by the staff on duty. Each hostel room provides an amiable atmosphere and pollution-free environment, conducive to the mental, physical and spiritual development of the students and helps them become self-reliant.

Hostels in the school are self-contained with amenities such as reading rooms, indoor games room and dining hall with mess.

The deliberations of the Hostel are governed by the Hostel Committees which includes student representatives under the office. Working through this responsible body, the committee members lay down appropriate norms of behaviour to suit different situations and social occasions in the hostel including the norms for dining hall.

REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION

Admission to KBPS, Jammu itself is a proud privilege not only for the child but also for the parents and for the school too. Admission in KBPS Jammu is based strictly on merit. The registration can be done w.e.f. the last week of December. Registration forms will be available at the school office enclosed with this school prospectus. All the requirements mentioned in the registration form must be strictly followed. Candidates found eligible after the 'Aptitude Test' and the interview will be granted admission subject to the availability of the seats. As proposed by the Education authorities and the NEP-2020, the age-wise admission in various classes should accordingly be :-

Class 9	: 14+ Years
Class 10	: 15+ Years
Class 11	: 16+ Years
Class 12	: 17+ Years

After the child has qualified the 'Aptitude Test' and the Interview and the admission has been granted, the parents must immediately deposit the necessary fees as per the statement of fees of the school; failing which the offer of the admission may be communicated to the next eligible candidate. The mandatory documents to be submitted at the time of admission are:

- Birth Certificate (In Original)
- Transfer Certificate of last attended school (In Original)
- Mark-sheet of last attended school (Photo copy)
- Aadhaar card of the child (Photo copy)
